RESIDENT HANDBOOK SECTION VII: GME OFFICE RESPONSIBILITIES

MALPRACTICE INSURANCE AND LIABILITY CLAIMS

- I. Residents have liability coverage only while they are carrying out assigned duties as part of their residency-training program in an affiliated institution.
 - a. Residents under contract with the Kirk Kerkorian School of Medicine at UNLV are covered for malpractice liability (limits \$1,000,000/\$3,000,000), except when working within the VA Medical Center.
 - b. Residents working within the VA Medical Center are covered by formal not covered
 - e. Intentional misconduct is generally not covered by insurance.
 - II. Liability Claims
 - a. A resident shall inform the residency program director *immediately* of an information concerning any potential malpractice insurance claim.
 - b. The program director shall notify the associate dean for graduate medica (GME). The associate dean for GME shall report the claim to the Kirk Ker Medicine at UNLV counsel who will in turn contact the insurance carrier.
 - c. The resident shall discuss the potential claim with *no one* else, other than Kerkorian School of Medicine at UNLV general counsel, the associate de medical education, the program director, or any attorney appointed to rep resident by the insurance carrier who will contact the resident involved dir possible, all conversations should be held in the presence of counsel. If a action is contemplated, others may need to be included in discussion with
 - d. It is imperative that there be no discussion with anyone else of the potent regardless of who may be involved or who should pose questions.
 - e. All questions concerning malpractice insurance coverage should be addre residency program director and/or the associate dean for GME.
