Top Tier 2.0 Metrics and Definitions

4-Year Graduation Rate (%)

Per IPEDS, FTFT degree-certificate seeking students who started and finished at the institution. Rate is calculated as the total number of completers within 100% of normal time divided by the revised adjusted cohort.

6-Year Graduation Rate (%)

Per IPEDS, FTFT degree-certificate seeking students who started and finished at the institution. Rate is calculated as the total number of completers within 150% of normal time divided by the revised adjusted cohort.

Admits

The number of graduate degree- and certificate-seeking applications that have been admitted. These data are pulled and summed by academic year defined as July to June or summer, fall, and spring for reporting purposes.

Capital Infusion (\$M)

Capital infusion (or capital formation) includes all forms of capital debt and/or investments from all sources (i.e., lines of credit, grants (such as SBIR/STTR), consumer debt products used specifically for the business, angel investors, owner's capital contributions, purchase or sale of a business etc.). Credit lines and other revolving debt facilities/instruments are to be recognized for the full amount of the line of credit when established and not to be based on individual drawdowns. Capital shall only be counted once the client has received the funds, not when they get notice of award approval.

Number of employees classified by HR as non-faculty researchers. Non-Faculty Researcher (must be easily identifiable for the GSS Survey)

- Must possess a doctorate degree (can be a professional doctorate e.g. MD).
- Not considered either a postdoc or a member of the instructional faculty.
- Must be a full-time employee.
- FTE dedicated to research must be greater than 50%.
- Involved principally in research disciplines that are under the domain of scientific research as listed on the National Science Foundation's GSS Code list.
- At institution anytime during the capture period (fall semester).

Number of Postdocs

Overall Satisfaction with Campus Services

A Business Affairs customer service survey is distributed annually to gather detailed feedback from the campus community's satisfaction and service experience. The survey consists of Likert scale questions that represent each area in the division. The goals and actuals are derived by looking at the base of the mean score on the Likert scale. The survey is distributed through Business Affairs Communication during the fall season.

Patents Filed

Social Mobility Index

Student Engagement (NSSE)

National Survey of Student Engagement, percent of seniors indicating that they have engaged in at least one high impact practice or are currently engaged in at least one.

Student Hours in School-Related Settings

The total number of hours UNLV students spend in CCSD and external charter school classrooms and school-related settings.

Student Participation in Service

Total number of students involved in service to the community.

Tenure of Faculty in Underrepresented Demographics

Tenure of faculty during the academic year, disaggregated by ethnicity.

Tenure/Tenure-track Faculty

The total number of tenure and tenure track faculty.

The Grad Academy - Opportunities Offered

Total number of programs, certifications, badges, workshops, and events provided to undergraduate and graduate students within The Grad Academy. The goal is to increase participation numbers significantly instead of number of offerings.

The Grad Academy Student Satisfaction

Satisfaction is measured by sending program participants Program Feedback Survey's in which they rate their overall experience with the program on a scale of 1-10. Programs included in this measurement include GRC, GMC, GCC, GTC, PGCPP, Ambassadors, RAMP, and GRWB. Satisfaction is measured by how

A count of the total number of undergraduate students that have documented UG student research involvement including professional development and career training workshops and presentations at UNLV conferences and competitions.

Undergraduates Accumulating 60+ Credits in Milestone Experience

The percentage of degree seeking undergraduates enrolled at the fall preliminary census date that have completed a Milestone Experience course with a C- or better (including S and P grades) and have accumulated 90+ credit hours at the College Level.
