V. Annual Attestation Statement.

To support institutional officers in their responsibility to make University-wide attestations, an annual attestation statement of Vice Presidents, and College, Division, and Departmental Business Officers, and their respective Business Officers will be required to execute the following attestation on or before July 1st of each year for the ensuing fiscal year.
